Comments

When visitors leave comments on our site, we collect the information provided in the comments form. In addition, we gather the visitor's IP address and browser user agent string to assist with spam detection.

An anonymized string created from your email address (also known as a hash) may be shared with the Gravatar service to determine if you are using it. You can review the Gravatar service privacy policy at:

<https://automattic.com/privacy/>. Once your comment is approved, your profile picture becomes publicly visible in the context of your comment.

Media

If you upload images to the website, please avoid including embedded location data (EXIF GPS) in your images. Visitors to the website can download and extract location data from images posted on the site.

Cookies

If you leave a comment on our site, you can choose to save your name, email address, and website in cookies. These cookies are for your convenience, so you do not need to re-enter your details when leaving another comment. These cookies will remain active for one year.

If you visit our login page, a temporary cookie will be set to check if your browser accepts cookies. This cookie contains no personal data and is removed when you close your browser.

When you log in, we will set multiple cookies to save your login information and your screen display choices. Login cookies are valid for two days, and screen options cookies last for one year. If you select “Remember Me,” your login will persist for two weeks. Logging out of your account will remove the login cookies.

If you edit or publish an article, an additional cookie is saved in your browser. This cookie contains no personal data and simply indicates the post ID of the article you edited. It expires after one day.

Embedded Content from Other Websites

These external sites may collect data about you, use cookies, incorporate additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with the embedded content, including tracking your interactions if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

Who We Share Your Data With

If you request a password reset, your IP address will be included in the reset email.

How Long We Retain Your Data

If you leave a comment, both the comment and its metadata are stored indefinitely. This allows us to recognize and automatically approve any subsequent comments instead of holding them in a moderation queue.

For users who register on our website (if any), we also store the personal information provided in their user profile. All users can view, edit, or delete their personal information at any time, except that they cannot change their username. Website administrators can also access and edit this information.
